

Algebra Classroom Supplies

2017-2018

Students must bring the following supplies to every class session:

- Pencil
- Separate Eraser
- Red Pen
- Graphing Notebook
- Straight Edge
- Graphing Calculator
- Book Cover for Textbook

Pencil - Mechanical pencils are recommended, but not required.

Eraser - In addition to an eraser on the end of a pencil, students must have a separate eraser.

Red Pen - Any red pen is fine for correcting assignments. Other colors may be substituted, but avoid purple at all costs.

Graphing Composition Book - Either 4x4 or 5x5 graph paper is acceptable. The pages will remain in the journal, so tear-out pages are strongly discouraged. A standard composition book style generally works best. Might be a good idea to buy several, because students will use at least three throughout the year.

Straight Edge - Any straight edge is fine. It does not need to have measurements. Six inches is long enough. Cheap plastic (i.e., protractors) is not recommended because it always breaks during the 1st trimester.

Graphing Calculator - Graphing Calculator - Any calculator in either the TI-83 or TI-84 series is acceptable. They are both issued in several editions (i.e., Plus, Silver Edition, Color Edition), but any edition will work. Expect to spend around \$100. Current models are listed here: <https://education.ti.com/en/products?category=graphing-calculators>. As of this writing, the newest model is the TI-84 Plus CE.

Book Cover – The textbook is 10.25” tall by 9.25” wide by 1.5” thick.
