Next year, Colleen O'Leary will be the Scrip chair. She has been training with Patti for a year and is ready to launch a new program. Scrip sales will be different next year. There will not be AM or PM sales. All Scrip purchases will be done online or by pre-ordering beginning Sept 2018. Families can submit their orders on Mondays, and pick them up on Fri-

days, or order online through Presto Pay and Great Lakes.

FINDERS FEE \$200. Beginning March 1, ICRS is increasing the finder's fee to \$200 for every new K-8 student from a new family (\$75 for new PK student from a new family). Our goal is to gain 15 new K-8 students next fall. We have seats available for more friends. Let your friends know about ICRS.

*Earn \$200 **Finder's Fee:** Existing families who are instrumental in bringing a new family to our school may apply for a Finder's Fee (\$200 per new K-8 student, and \$50 per new pre-K student). The new family should name the existing family on their online application form. The existing family needs to sign up to be a mentoring family for the new family. Checks will be written at the end of 18 weeks should the new family remain in the up to that time and the new family is current with fees and tuition.*
