PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

I'm speaking at Masses this month, highlighting three ICRS successes. First, thanks to a generous donation from Mr. Lyde Herlle, ICRS is remodeling the old auditorium into our new state-of-the-art library/media center this summer. Come and see the architect drawings in the office. Second, our first STORM fund exceeded its goal by more than \$20,000. Funds raised are purchasing new science curriculum for K-8, new laptops for teachers which will be compatible with new technology in each classroom. Third, thanks to an innovative partnership ICRS has with DCG, engineers bring their expertise into our classrooms to support

student learning—a great thank you to Jordan, Kelly and Selina.

Mass might be an easy opportunity for you to piggy back on my efforts and draw new families to our school. While at Mass, turn to the family next to you and introduce yourself.
