All parents are invited to participate in field day with their children. Lunch will begin at 10:50 AM. If you would like to come for lunch or help with lunch or games, please turn in the form below as soon as possible. We are asking each class to bring the following for our lunch at St. Joseph Center.

- K – ready to serve fresh fruit or veggies
- 1st – paper plates and cups
- 2nd – juice (bulk, no cans or boxes)
- 3rd – chips and cookies
- 4th – hamburger buns and mustard
- 5th – ketchup and pre-sliced cheddar cheese
- 6th – ready to serve fresh fruit and veggies
- 7th – pickles, lettuce, tomato, and mayo
- 8th – individually wrapped, nut-free candy and water balloons

The games will run from 12:15 until 1:30. All students will be arranged in multi-age “families” and will participate in each game in a group of about 12 students. You are welcome to join your child’s “family”.

At about 1:45 the traditional staff vs. the 8th grade volleyball game will start in, or next to, the Saint Joseph Center. Younger students will be allowed to play on the playground.
